CLASSES: Baby Puppy (judged after BOB), Minor Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Graduate, SA Bred, Veteran, Open & Champion

ORDER OF JUDGING: In terms of Schedule 3, Reg. 5.5.1 the order in which the Breed Classes, Best in Group classes and Best in Show classes will be judged:

BREED JUDGING: All breed classes except Baby Puppy, followed by Best of Breed, Best Puppy, Best Junior, Best Veteran etc. Thereafter Baby Puppies
judged together i.e., Dog and Bitch

GROUP JUDGING: Main Group, Puppy, Junior, Veteran followed by Baby Puppy

BEST IN SHOW JUDGING: Best Baby Puppy, Best in Show, Best Puppy, Best Junior & Best Veteran

Presentation of exhibit's bite to judge, may be presented by exhibitor themselves

Conditions attracting immediate disqualification are set out in Reg. 4 of Schedule 4 and Reg. 31 of Schedule
