Qualifying cards must be produced prior to entering the ring.

The Club reserves the right to appoint alternate judges should any of the above be unable to officiate. No RAF or TAF dogs will be accepted. Any incomplete or illegible entries, or those unaccompanied by the correct fees, will be returned. Any dog entered incorrectly will automatically be entered in the Open Class. No changes will be made at the Show.

N.B. EXHIBITORS' NUMBERS ARE TO BE COLLECTED ON THE MORNING OF THE SHOW. THIS SHOW WILL BE HELD UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE KENNEL UNION OF SOUTHERN AFRICA.

All Exhibitors/Handlers are personally responsible for the control of their dogs at all times and shall be personally liable for any claims which may be made in respect of injuries which may arise or be caused by their dogs.

Only members of the Kennel Union shall be entitled to enter dogs in their registered ownership in any Championship Dog Show licensed by the Kennel Union.

Puppies under 4 months are not eligible for exhibition.

The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

Conditions attracting immediate disqualification are set out in Regulations 7 & 31 of Schedule 3.

COVID-19

KUSA appeals to attendees at all licensed events to keep up basic precautions whenever possible to prevent a surge of infections, including:

- **Wearing a mask that covers your nose and mouth**
*Masks are no longer obligatory outdoors, but **must be worn indoor public spaces** – this includes the Organiser's Office at KUSA licensed events whether in a building or marquee.*
- **Keeping a safe distance from others and avoiding crowded areas**
- **Washing or sanitising your hands regularly**

All venues are limited to 50% of their capacity with an upper limit of 1000 indoors and 2000 outdoors (unless proof of vaccine or negative COVID test is required, in which case there is no upper limit)

Please note that by entering and/or attending this event, participants are agreeing to comply with any instructions issued by the Show Manger and/or COVID-19 Compliance Officer/s, (if appointed by the club), and that the organisers have the right to request any person who refuses to comply with a request or instruction to leave the venue. Any person found to be non-compliant may also be liable for disciplinary action under Schedule 1 of the KUSA Constitution.
