Agility: (Contact and Non-contact) and Dog jumping: R100 per dog per Class. R160 for same dog for two Classes. R190 for same dog three Classes.

Breed: (including Veterans and Baby Puppy): R160 per dog per Class.

Flyball: R280 per team of six.

Obedience: R100 per dog per Class.

Child/Junior Handler: R15 per Handler

Please add R30 to each cash deposit directly into the bank account to cover bank charges.

All Child and Junior Handlers to complete separate Entry Forms and supply copies of Birth Certificates.

The Show Catalogue for Breed will be distributed digitally to Owners/Authorised Agents of dogs entered in the Show, but not before two (2) hours prior to the start of judging.

Order of Judging: Groups and Best in Show Finals:

Best Baby Puppy in Group/Show, Best in Group/Show, Best Puppy in Group/Show, Best Junior in Group/Show, Best Veteran in Group/Show

Order of Judging Breed:

All Breed Classes, except Baby Puppy, followed by Best of Breed, Best Puppy, Best Junior, Best Veteran, etc. Thereafter Baby Puppy Dog & Baby Puppy Bitch, followed by Best Baby Puppy.

The Club reserves the right to appoint alternate Judges should any of the above be unable to officiate or have too many entries. No RAF or TAF dogs will be accepted. Any incomplete or illegible entries, or those accompanied by the incorrect fees, will be returned. Any dog entered incorrectly in an age-restricted Class will automatically be entered in the Open Class. No changes will be made at the Show.

This Show will be held under the Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa.

ALL EXHIBITORS/HANDLERS ARE PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTROL OF THEIR DOGS AT ALL TIMES AND SHALL BE PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR ANY CLAIMS RESULTING FROM INJURIES CAUSED BY THEIR DOGS.

Only Members of the Kennel Union shall be entitled to enter dogs in their registered ownership in any Championship Dog Show licensed by the Kennel Union.

The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

Puppies under four (4) months are not eligible for exhibition at the Show.

Please take note of the following COVID-19 Protocols & Procedures to be observed at this Event:

- A maximum of 2000 people will be allowed at the Event, which will be held outdoors.
- All persons attending this Event must wear a reusable cloth or sponge face mask, or a disposable surgical mask, except when running while handling a dog in competition. Face shields only are not acceptable. Any person not wearing a mask, will be requested to leave the venue.
- All attendees must observe social distancing and, whenever possible, maintain a distance of at least 1.5 metres between themselves and others with whom they don't cohabit.
- Sanitiser will be available at the Show Office, on all Judges' tables, at ring entrances and in the toilet areas.

Please note that, by entering and/or attending this Event, participants are agreeing to comply with any instructions issued by the COVID-19 Compliance Officers, and that the organisers have the right to request any person who refuses to comply with a request or instruction to leave the venue. Any person found to be non-compliant may also be liable for disciplinary action under Schedule 1 of the KUSA Constitution. The above Protocols and Procedures are subject to immediate change should the Alert Level change, or the Government Regulations pertaining to COVID-19 be varied prior to the Event.
