BREED CLASSES: Baby Puppy*, Minor Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Graduate, Open, Champion, SA Bred, Veterans. *not eligible for CC or BOB.



ENTRY FEES: Breed (all classes): R190.00 per dog per class
Handling classes: Free, if the dog has been entered into a breed
Agility (Contact & Non-Contact) and Dog Jumping:
R120.00 per dog per class, R160.00 for same dog for two classes, R220.00 for same dog for three classes.
R900 per dog (for the same dog) entering all 5 shows for all 3 classes per show (R180 payable to each club per dog)
Rally: R120 per dog per class
R200 per dog if entering 2 shows. (R100 payable to each club per dog)
Obedience: R100 per dog per class

Catalogues will be published on the morning of the show

Trailers may be brought onto grounds, but judging will not commence before cars have been removed. Camping is permitted in designated area.

Best in Show: Best Baby Puppy in Show, Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show, Best Junior in Show, Best SA Bred in Show, Best Veteran in Show.

NB: GSSG will start at 8am, GSNG will follow on completion of judging in each ring provided that the scheduled judge is available. Best In Show (GSSG) will take place after judging is completed in all rings for GSSG. Best In Show (GSNG) will take place on completion of Best In Show (GSSG).

Handling classes will take place for both shows before the Best In Show.

Bitches in season are allowed to compete in Breed, Agility and Dog Jumping only.

Qualifying cards must be produced prior to entering the ring.

The Club reserves the right to appoint alternate judges should any of the above be unable to officiate. No RAF or TAF dogs will be accepted. Any incomplete or illegible entries, or those unaccompanied by the correct fees, will be returned. Any dog entered incorrectly will automatically be entered in the Open Class. No changes will be made at the Show.

N.B. EXHIBITORS' NUMBERS ARE TO BE COLLECTED ON THE MORNING OF THE SHOW.

THIS SHOW WILL BE HELD UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE KENNEL UNION OF SOUTHERN AFRICA.

All Exhibitors/Handlers are personally responsible for the control of their dogs at all times and shall be personally liable for any claims which may be made in respect of injuries which may arise or be caused by their dogs.

Only Members of the Kennel Union shall be entitled to enter dogs in their registered ownership in any Championship Dog Show licensed by the Kennel Union.

Puppies under 4 months are not eligible for exhibition.

The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

Conditions attracting immediate disqualification are set out in Regulations 7 & 31 of Schedule 3.
