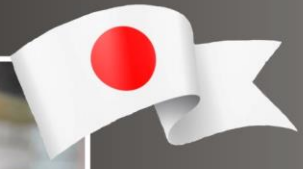

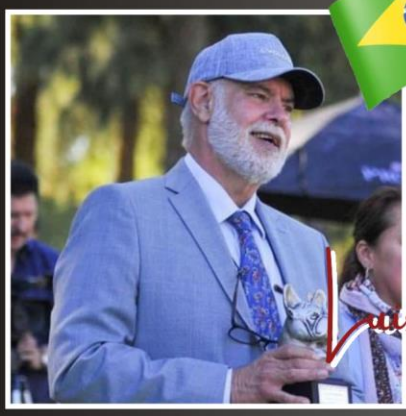

Teena Sloan

KILLILAN was established over 35 years ago with the beautiful breed of Boxers. Boxers have always been in the family and my mother used to show them 60 years ago. For almost 25 years I bred and showed this wonderful Breed, in total over 40 Champions were bred or owned under my prefix, many many of them Best In Show winners. I also exhibited many more to their Championship titles. My first Boxer was a stunner, Ch Phoenix The Taxman, "Bodie", the ultimate showman. Multiple Best In Show Winner and countless Groups, Tasmania's Top Dog All Breeds, Royal Best In Show Winner. he was my heart and soul dog and my constant shadow and the only dog that would show only for me. In my years of breeding, I fell in love with the American style of Boxers. 'Salgrays', Merrilanes', 'Jacquets' and 'Tradonalees' were just a few of the great American imports I used successfully. Their clean heads and their substance with elegance was just stunning.

I still passionately love this Breed and it will always be one of my heart Breeds, but I am now owned by my main Breed of Shih Tzu of which I have bred over 30 Champions, including the Multi Best In Show Grand Champion Killilian Spank Me Not and the stunning bitch Multi BIS Grand Champion Killilian I Rock My World, "Macy", Multi Best In Show winning Supreme Ch Killilian I Rest My Case Your Honour, who was sired by my Multi Best In Show winning Am Ch/Supreme Ch Wenrick's Capture The Moment (Imp Can). Again, the American style has captured my heart in my Shih Tzu. My homebred boy, Supreme Ch Killilian Defence Rests Yr Honour, "Eamon" is currently being campaigning. He is currently Australia's No One Shih Tzu and No 2 All-Breeds in Tasmania with 60 Best In Show/Best In Show 2nd awards and over 140 Best In Groups. Just earlier this year he was Tasmania's representative at the prestigious Top Dog Awards Ceremony in Canberra. He is 2nd only to the Breed Record Holder in Australia, the great past Champion, Ch Erinto Yankee Storm, bred by J Sheppard & owned by E & M Pickering. Interestingly enough, my first litter was out of an 'Erinto' dog, heavily American bred. To say I am a proud breeder/owner handler of this Shih Tzu is an understatement.

New Breeds added to "Killilian" over the last 12 years, which have also been extremely successful are American Staffordshire Terriers, Skye Terriers, Dandie Dinmont Terriers and campaigning more than 15 to their titles, winning many Best In Shows along the way, and just for fun a Shiba Inu or 2 were thrown into the mix. Definitely not a Breed for the faint hearted and it was a short-lived dalliance although I did persevere and title 2 to their Championships but even 7-foot fences can't contain this Breed. The naughtiness and 'out there' attitude of the Boxer, the arrogance and beauty of the Shih Tzu, the aloofness and dignity of the Skye, the stubbornness coupled with the melting eyes of the Dandie, the powerhouse of the Amstaff and the wickedness of the Shiba have all combined to make it a most interesting place at "KILLILAN".

I have been judging for over 20 years and obtained my All-Breeds status in 2009. I have judged many times in all States and Territories of Australia, both the North and South Islands of New Zealand, Japan, China, Philippines and South Africa. I am honoured to be selected to judge at this prestigious weekend of events and look forward to seeing your beautiful dogs.

In the middle of the 80s, after returning from the USA, with my newly acquired Rough Collie, I began to attend dog shows in the state of Minas Gerais and immediately registered my kennel at the CBKC (Brazilian Confederation of Dog Breeding), under the suffix "South Louisiana", in homage to the state where I lived in the USA.

Shortly after, I founded the Kennel Club of Divinópolis in Minas Gerais, which I was president of. I was also a Member of the Council of the Minas Gerais Federation of Cinophilia. Participant and enthusiastic about Cynology, I graduated as an International FCI Judge for All Breeds, periodically judging general and specialised dog shows in Brazil and abroad.

In my trajectory in the dogshow world, I bred : Rough Collies, Dalmatians, Labrador Retrievers, Miniature Schnauzers (all colours), Standard Short-haired Daschunds, Rottweilers and Bulldogs. I own, but I do not breed, a Siberian Husky and an Akita. Since the 2000's I have consistently worked exclusively with French Bulldogs, but recently I started a project with Shih Tzus along with a partner.

Please take note of the following:

- Only dogs with a KUSA Registration Number are eligible to enter Shows and those dogs which have been given showing dispensation by the KUSA Office for these Shows.
- **Only Members of the Kennel Union shall be entitled to enter dogs in their registered ownership in any Championship Dog Show licensed by the Kennel Union.**
- Exhibits **will be marked absent** if called 3 times.
- The mating or whelping of bitches within the precincts of the Show venue is forbidden.
- Bitches in season may only be shown in Breed Classes at all events and exhibitors must exercise due consideration towards other exhibits.
- No animal other than an exhibit entered for competition or exhibition shall be allowed on the grounds, with the exception of registered guide dogs.
- No late entries will be accepted.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to allocate to Open Class any dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible.
- No refunds of entry fees will be made for any errors whatsoever made by the owner/exhibitor/authorised agent.
- All owners/exhibitors/authorised agents/handlers are advised that they and any exhibit entered in any event over the KUSA Classic Weekend may be photographed for, by, or on behalf of KUSA for the use and possible publication of such photograph by KUSA. A special area for the taking of photographs will be provided.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to appoint alternative Judges; re-allocate Breeds and advise all exhibits entered; or adjust the judging times prior to the Show, should the appointed Judges be unable to officiate, or receive too large or too small an entry.
- Order of Breed judging for the Championship Shows is in alphabetical order in accordance with Schedule 2 Appendix "A", unless otherwise indicated.
- The KUSA website, KUSA Classic 2024 Facebook Page and KUSA Classic 2024 WhatsApp Group are the only communication media officially recognised by the Show Committee.

The FCI Show is held under the Rules of the FCI, which include the following:

- The dogs' welfare must be of utmost priority at all dog Shows. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that can be dangerous for its health and welfare, such as leaving it in the car in excessively hot or cold weather and/or treating it in a cruel manner. Violation of this rule will result in exclusion from the present and future dog Shows.
- The FCI Show is judged according to FCI Breed Standards.
- Double entries and late entries (after the closing date) are not permitted.
- No transfer by an exhibitor of a dog from one Class to another is permitted after the closing date.
- The FCI-Reserve C.A.C.I.B.@ is awarded to the second-best dog which was given the qualification "Excellent" from the eligible Classes. The dog placed second in the Class from which the FCI-C.A.C.I.B.@ Winner was awarded may compete for the FCI-Reserve C.A.C.I.B.@, if awarded an "Excellent" grading. It is not compulsory to award the FCI-Reserve C.A.C.I.B.@.
- The Best Junior, FCI-C.A.C.I.B.@ Winner, and Best Veteran from both sexes, if awarded an "Excellent" grading, will compete for Best of Breed (BOB). The Judge must also choose the best exhibit from the opposite sex (BOS) next to the BOB Winner.
- If a dog behaves aggressively in the ring (breed-group-finals) and its behaviour is eye-witnessed by the Judge on duty, the latter must submit a report for the attention of the Organising Committee and must disqualify the dog for the rest of the competition. All the awards and titles of the day are consequently cancelled.
- Where FCI regulations are not covered, then KUSA Schedule 3 shall take effect.
- All the other Shows will be held according to the Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa.
- Please keep the grounds and bathrooms clean.
- When grooming and/or exercising your dogs, please clean up after them. Do not leave it for others or the ring stewards to do.

ALL EXHIBITORS/HANDLERS ARE PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTROL OF THEIR DOGS AT ALL TIMES AND SHALL BE PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL CLAIMS IN RESPECT OF INJURIES WHICH MAY BE CAUSED BY THEIR DOGS.

RIGHT OF ADMISSION RESERVED

Our Right of Admission Reserved is based on our right of "Freedom of Association" as enshrined in Section 18 of the Constitution, insofar as members of the public and even KUSA's own members fail to adhere to the general principles of good order, acceptable behaviour and social decorum customarily required at dog shows. This is likely to include people who are rowdy, drunk, naked, loud or obscene, or who engage in physical violence and/or verbal abuse of other members of the public and of KUSA, or who play loud music or engage in any behaviour that prohibits or limits KUSA and its members from participating in their chosen activity unhindered. In a nutshell, Right of Admission Reserved would sanction the denial of access to, or expulsion from, the premises of persons who indulge in unacceptable conduct and behaviour and who disrupt the good order and social discipline required at dog shows.
